Highlights of the Academic Audit 2019-2020 (Shift 1 & Shift 2)

Strengths:

- Value -added courses that enhance skills of the students have been offered by few departments
- Almost all the departments use online teaching and testing tools to the maximum extent. The innovative teaching methodologies used are highly commendable.
- Many departments have introduced new courses during the academic year and except for two departments all the other departments focus on offering employability, skill development courses etc.
- Most of the departments provide On-the-Job training opportunity to their students to have hands on experience in industries related to their subjects.
- Student Progression to higher studies and placements obtained are in good proportion to the class strength that reflects on the quality of students produced
- The faculty have participated very actively in presenting papers in seminars and conferences
- Active participation of students in extracurricular and co-curricular activities.

Suggestions for Improvement:

- More courses that focus on Entrepreneurship, Skill development, Employability, Gender and Environmental Sensitization should be introduced as part of the curriculum
- Publishing research papers in refereed journals has to be increased to enhance the research culture in the institution and effort must be taken to publish more patents as well
- The contribution from faculty towards writing books or chapters in books needs to increase.
- Need to have more Smart Classroom facilities to improve ICT enabled teaching-learning process.

- PG departments have to enhance their research capabilities by helping students focus on relevant research, whose outcome can be published in refereed journals with high impact factor.
- E- Contents have to be developed for more topics in all the courses and make initiatives to upload the same in SWAYAM MOOCs platform NPTEL/NMEICT or institutional (Learning Management System (LMS) portals.
- The numbers of students qualifying in competitive exams are very low and that needs to be addressed.
