LAUNCH OF 5G SERVICES BY HON'BLE PRIME MINISTER

The Outcome of the activity:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched 5G services in India on Saturday, calling it a "step towards the new era." The launch in select cities will cover the entire country over the next couple of years, a government statement said. PM Modi launched the much-awaited services that aim to provide seamless coverage, high data rate, less delay in internet connectivity and highly reliable communications in the presence of India's telecom leaders in New Delhi. "This event will be etched in history," Modi said at the launch. He said it was a "step towards the new era in the country" and "the beginning of infinite opportunities."

Reliance Jio telecom company plans to start in four metropolitan areas in October and hopes to reach most cities and towns in 18 months. The government said that the cumulative economic impact of 5G on India is expected to reach \$450 billion by 2035.


- 1. Reliance, Airtel and Vodafone Idea the three major telecom operators demonstrated one use case each in front of the prime minister to show the potential of 5G technology in India.
- 2. "5G is much more than the next generation of technology", said Reliance's Mukesh Ambani while addressing the event.
- 3. Reliance Industries Ltd.'s 5G network aims to cover the remotest corners of India by December next year, Ambani said.
- 4. The 5G services would also help India add to its unicorn list, Bharti Mittal of Bharti Enterprises asserted. "With the advent of 5G, I'm sure that the country will add many more unicorns in the world"
- 5. Delhi, Mumbai, Varanasi, and Bangalore are among the eight cities where Airtel said it would launch its services on Saturday.
- 6. From 6 crore internet users in 2014 to 80 crore users now, the penetration has been deepening, according to the government.
- 7. Our Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi Ji inaugurated the event making the launch of 5G a grand success.
- 8. The speakers of the day were Mr. Sunil Dutt, President Devices, Reliance JIO, Mr. Nader Atteya, Senior Strategy & Technology Manager, MediaTek Europe, Mr. Ajey Mehta, Global Vice President Corporate Business Development, HMD Global, Mr. Kuldeep Malik Director Corporate Sales India, MediaTek; Mr. Vishal Gondal Founder & CEO, GOQII, Mr. Anuj Sidharth Deputy Director Marketing & Communications, MediaTek India, Mr. Vivek Yadav Sr. Vice President & Business Head, Havells and Mr. Neil Shah Partner & Vice President, Counterpoint.
- 9. Mukesh Ambani from Reliance, Akash Ambani from Jio, Sunil Kumar Mittal from Airtel, and Kumar Mangalam Birla from Aditya Birla group were present along with Prime Minister Modi to demonstrate the working of 5G services.


Key highlights



days. The main motive of this workshop is to empower women by teaching them how to cultivate mushrooms. Hence this helps them to become entrepreneurs. Many colleges around Chennai participated with no registration fee. All the raw materials were provided to every participant.

ACTIVITY:

The first day was focusing on all the theory parts. The participants were taught in a very detailed manner about the basics and the different methods involved in the cultivation of mushrooms by the resource person. A tea break was given in between and the participants went to the mushroom house. The initial step of mushroom cultivation, soaking the straw alone, was done by the participants and the steps to be followed the next day were planned accordingly. For the next day, the participants are asked to come directly to the field. They dried all the straw they soaked the prior day and packed the mushroom bags with the required amount of spawn in it. Around 30 bags were packed by the participants and finally hanged in the mushroom house. And finally the participants were assembled in the conference hall for valedictory and each one of them received participation certificates.

Through comprehensive training workshops and mentorship, we aim to create a sustainable ecosystem that empowers these women to overcome socio-economic challenges, embrace entrepreneurship as a path to financial independence, and contribute to the growth and vitality of their local economies.

Ms. Amala delivered an introductory speech on entrepreneurship, setting the stage for the event. Dr. B.S. Catherine then took the floor, sharing inspiring stories of women entrepreneurs who overcame hurdles to achieve remarkable success. Subsequently, Dr. Margaret Marie enhanced the engagement by showcasing informative videos portraying young women entrepreneurs who encountered challenges and emerged triumphant in their ventures. The videos highlighted their journey, motivating the audience and instilling a sense of determination to pursue their own entrepreneurial aspirations.

Following the faculty's speeches, the students took charge and organized a series of enjoyable events to create a lively atmosphere. Divided into two groups of seven students each, they conducted engaging activities related to entrepreneurship.




registered participants. It was held at Benedicta Rowe, Women's Christian College at 10:00 AM.


The three rounds of the event were Crossword (preliminary round), Cinebiz and Biz Speak
