Srimathi Rukmini Lakshmipathi (1892 -1951) obtained her B.A. from Women's Christian College, Madras in 1918. A freedom fighter and Social Reformer belonging to the Indian National Congress, she was the first woman to be elected to the Madras Legislature and the first and only woman to serve as a Minister in the Madras Presidency. In 1930, she became the first female prisoner when she was jailed for a year for her participation in the Salt Sathyagraha in Vedaranyam. She holds the honour of being the first woman Deputy Speaker of the Assembly prior to Independence. To honour her, Marshalls Road in Egmore, Chennai was renamed Rukmini Lakshmipathy Road and a commemorative postage stamp released in 1997.
