and Findings, Conclusion, Limitations and
Future Research, References

Abstract should not be more than 250 words.
Research paper should not be more than 2500
words.

Paper title, authors name and affiliation,
contact number and email address should be
included on the first page of the Article.

All photographs, charts and diagrams are to be
referred as 'Figures' and should be numbered
consecutively.

Abstract and full paper must be typed in Times
New Roman, Font Size 12 , line spacing 1.5 and
must have a margin of 1 inch on all sides.

**Participants are free to choose from the sub-
themes provided or any other topic related to
the overarching theme of the event**

Papers should be presented by the author/co-
author using a PowerPoint presentation.

**The Best Paper Award will be rewarded as per
the judges' discretion.**
