ABOUT THE LIBRARY

The Information Resource Centre (IRC), the erstwhile library, was initially located in the upper floor of Doveton House with the collection of donated books by friends of the college. The new library building was established on 28th January, 1966. The American Associate Board and the UGC helped with funds for this project, and the alumni of Mount Holyoke College generously equipped the library with books, periodicals and journals.

Currently, the 14,740 sq.ft library with 425 seating capacity houses 92000 plus print documents and a wide range of e-resources. It subscribes to database comprising a vast e-resource collection 7,99,500+ e-books and 7391+ e-journals (through NLIST, NDLI & EBSCOhost) catering to needs of the entire WCC community. IRC works from 7.30am to 6.00pm on all working days for students and staff of the college. Apart from the required standard infrastructure, the library is Wi-Fi enabled and fully automated using ILMs – Autolib with bar-code/RFID facility. IRC is centrally located to all the academic and administrative blocks. It has adequate computers, projector, interactive board, large television that augments the usage of ICT facilities. The collection is open access and classified using Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC). It has augmented the services in 2023 with International Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC), and Library Mobile App. Complete safety is ensured with surveillance cameras, fire Extinguishers and ramp facility. Library Executive Committee acts as an advisory committee, meets annually and discusses library expenses, services, policies and procedures. The reference section of the library is equipped with research carrels and a sufficient number of computers with laptop facilities. Digital Library Section has a projector, interactive smart board, desktops access with Wi-Fi facility. 24/7 remote access is provided to access external resources though NLIST, EBSCOhost and NDLI. Registered with expert database VIDWAN and IRINS web-based Research Information Management Service to measure the research impact. Library subscribes to Turnitin plagiarism detection software to uphold academic integrity. To augment the gateway to researchers MoU is signed between WCC and INFLIBNET Shodhchakra in February 2024. Institutional Repository provides access to the College magazine from 1915 till date. The collection of the library's archives with rare books, WCC's author's corner, photographs, manuscripts, artefacts, digitized College magazines etc., are a boon to the digital humanity.

In addition to modern facilities, the library promotes Indian traditional practices of Indigenous Herbal methods of pest control systems. It enhances the services by collaborating with other prominent libraries through institutional memberships. On an average usage of the library per day has considerably grown from 145 plus to 300 plus in the last 5 years. Systematic Information Literacy programs, Readers Forum, Bibliographic compilations, Know Your Library tours, National Library Week, conference, workshops, FDPs are conducted to connect, augment usage and to promote research activities to ensure maximum ROI. Exclusive sections for competition examinations, foreign languages, women's studies cater to specific requirements. Aiming at the goal for inclusive education, the library has opted for Sugamya Pustakalaya membership, Pearl Open Book Scanner with JAWS software to visually challenged students.

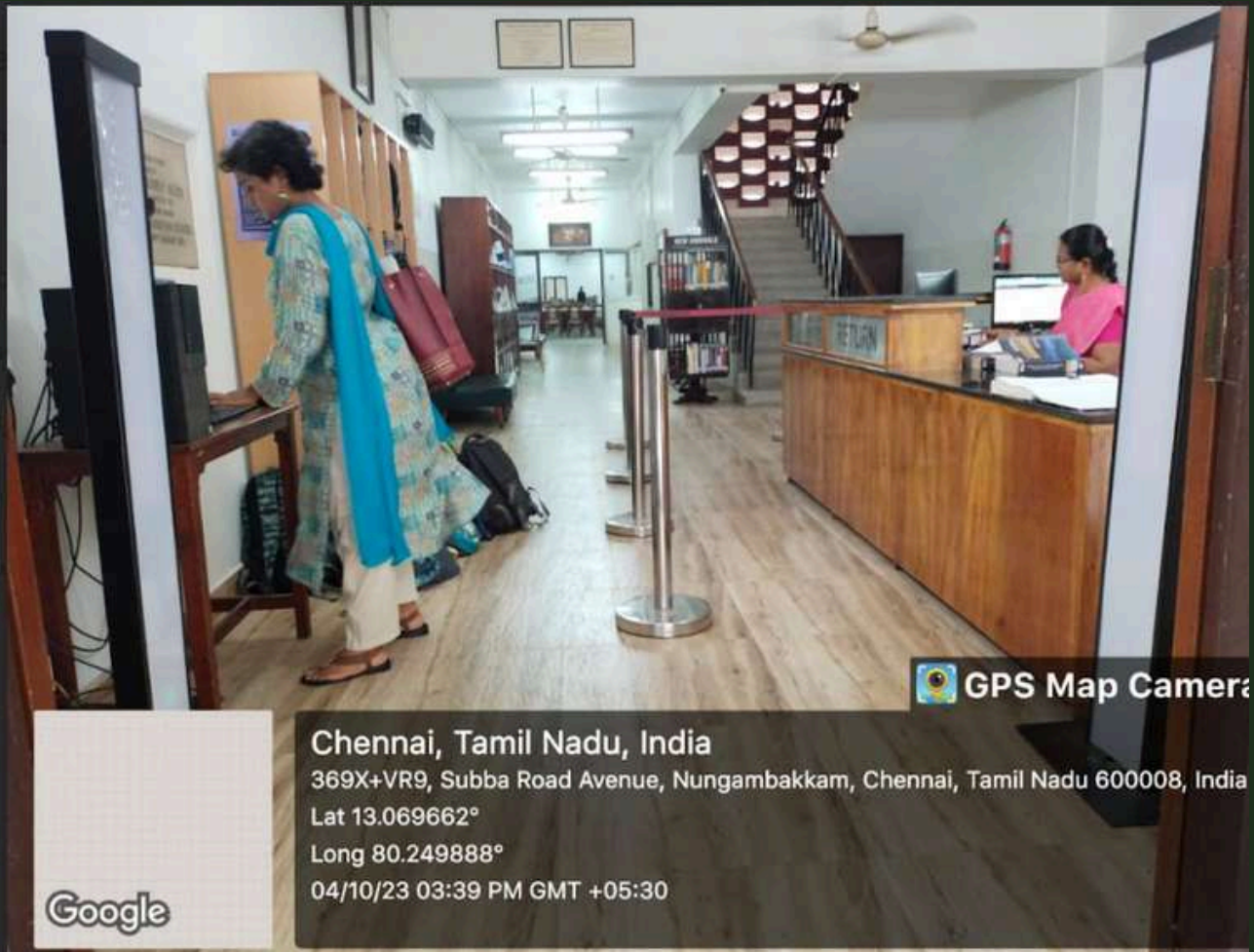

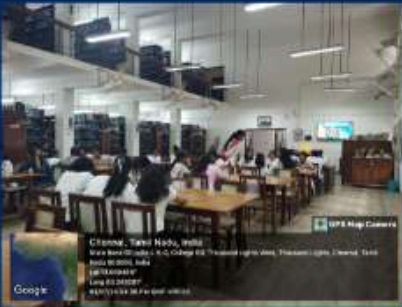

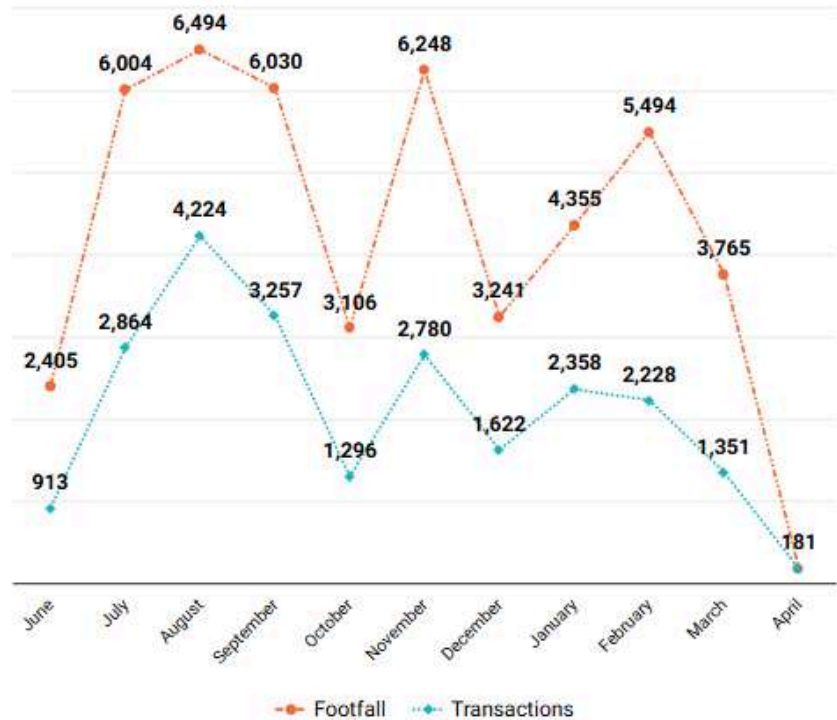

January, 2024 - Three computers at the library were equipped with **JAWS talking screen readers for the visually challenged students (Divyangjan)**, which were purchased through the Karishma India Literacy Project. Furthermore, a sophisticated camera device known as the Pearl Openbook Hi-speed scanner reader version 9 was purchased. This device turns a PC running the Openbook OCR software into a high-speed text reading system, allowing visually challenged students to read on their own. Three visually impaired students receive training on a regular basis.



January 19, 2023 - Dr. J. Lisa Sheba Rani, Librarian was nominated as the Nodal Officer for the **'Shodhchakra'** (<https://shodhchakra.inflibnet.ac.in/>) related activities for Women's Christian College. WCC has received the credentials to access ShodhChakra on 9th February 2024. In February 2024, a program of orientation and training will be held for researchers, guides, and other concerned officials by Shodhchakra team. **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** between Women's Christian College, Chennai, and Information and Library Network Centre, Gandhinagar, for Shodhchakra shall be signed after all formalities have been satisfactorily completed.

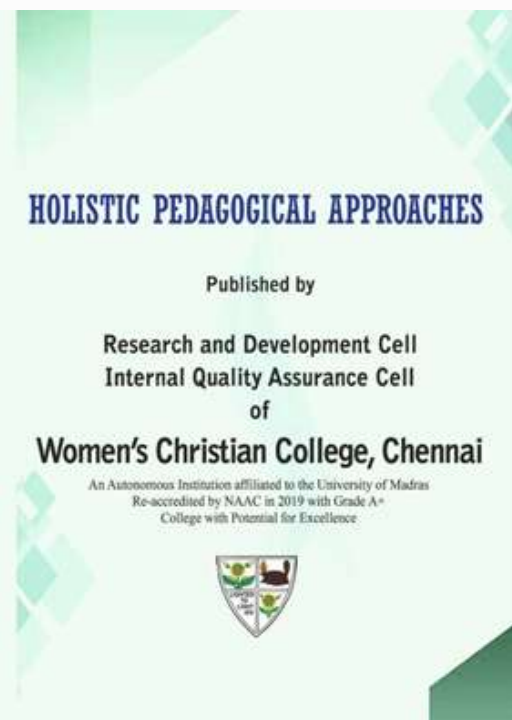
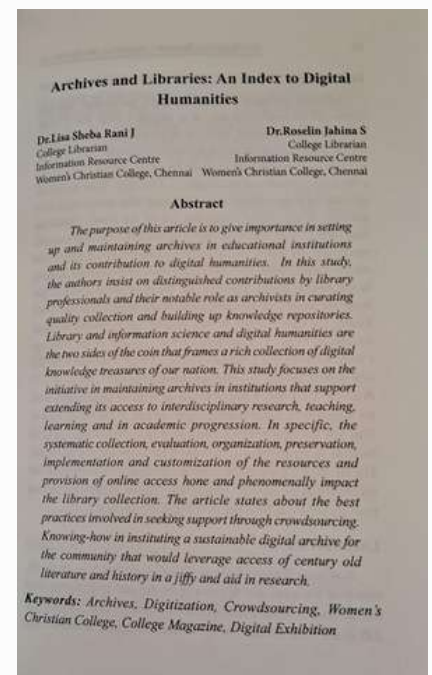
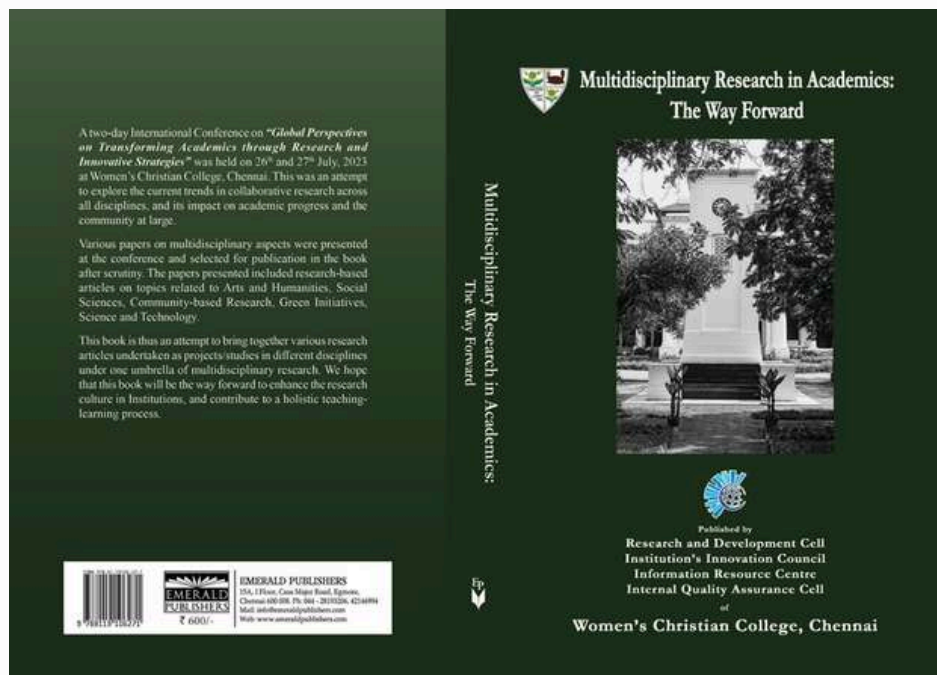

Abstract

This abstract outlines the efforts that are to be taken to create a Visually Impaired Students' Learning Nook in the library of Women's Christian College, Chennai in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. By providing visually impaired students with an accessible and encouraging learning environment, the main goal of this project is to promote inclusive education. The NEP 2020 emphasizes the value of equitable and inclusive education – learning for all and offers a thorough framework for accomplishing this objective. The proposed Learning Nook will be equipped with state-of-the-art modern assistive technologies, including screen readers, braille displays, accessible computers, software and membership with DAISY Forum, Suganya Pustakalaya for accessible education to strengthen the learning sources and services for visually impaired students. Additionally, the Nook will offer a wide range of accessible educational materials, including textbooks in braille and digital formats, reinforcing the NEP's emphasis on using

Indigenous Herbal Practices workshop was organized on 1st September, 2023. 32 faculty members participated and have experienced making fragrant customized indigenous herbal pest control sachets and have learned effective methods for employing herbal products for anti-bacterial and anti-fungal, odor-free cabinets, clean book shelves, and clean surfaces. The participants received instruction on how to recognize the plants and herbs best suited for natural pest management. Additional advice on when, where and how to use these organic products was provided by the trainer. This course helped participants develop their go green concepts and self-directed learning skills so they may follow their enthusiasm for rich traditional practices. The participants were given 5 sachets of herbal pesticide.





The Chennai Students' Readers Forum, the Information Resource Centre with the Departments of English (Shifts I & II), Women's Christian College, Chennai organised a **Meet the Author** session with the Tamil writer, Mr. Bava Chelladurai on the 19th September, 2023. 115 students and 13 faculty members and 2 library staff were present as audience. The session not only engaged the students in a relaxing session of story-telling but also created general awareness on the need for deconstructing established social norms that oppress and undermine a section of the society.




IRC has celebrated the **National Library Week 2023** with various events from 14th to 18th November, 2023. Screening of documentary Film, Book Talks, Book Review submissions, Poster Designing, Book Swap, and Step into the Library. The objective of the National Library Week was to make the users connect, understand and utilize the services and facilities available from the College Library. The footfall of the library has increased in this particular week, 2127 users have visited the library.



Hands-on-training was given on 'Effective Search Techniques and Application in Research' on 21st and 29th November 2023. 35 students and 3 faculty members from the department of Advanced Zoology & Biotechnology were the participants. With an objective to create awareness on the availability of subscribed and open access database, e-journals, e-books, to train the students in using the online tools effectively for their research work and to provide tips on efficiently using AI Tools to augment the project writing.
