5G services are set to launch in 13 cities in the first phase and are expected to cover all the cities and states in India by the end of 2023. Major cities like Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai, Kolkata, Hyderabad and Bengaluru might receive the services first. Mobile operators Jio, Airtel, Vodafone and Idea have notified the opening of 5G services as of now.

Mukesh Ambani from Reliance, Akash Ambani from Jio, Sunil Kumar Mittal from Airtel, Kumar Mangalam Birla from Aditya Birla group were present along with Prime Minister Modi to demonstrate the working of 5G services. The members, office bearers

and faculty coordinators of the innovation club and the entrepreneurship cell watched the event online and uploaded pictures of them watching the event.

The members got to know about the latest technological advancements taking place in India and got to witness the milestone achievement of launching 5g services in India through this event

The Innovation Club organized an industrial visit to Flamagas India Pvt. Ltd., Mambakkam, Chennai, India on 09 December 2022. A few members of the Innovation Club were accompanied by the Faculty Coordinator of the Innovation Club Dr. Hema Shankari. K and Dr. Irvin Mary. The club members along with the faculties arrived at the college from where they boarded the bus to the industry at 8:50am. The introductory meeting at the industry started at 10:30 pm after reaching the industry and exchanging introductions. The day plan was shared after which a presentation was played that elaborated on responsibilities and working conditions of the industry. Flamagas India is an industry that predominantly manufactures lighters (cigarette lighters and kitchen lighters) with about 330 industrial workers. They are a multinational company based in Spain and have 2 plants in India, both situated in Chennai. They went on to display their organizational chart and then discussed the various methods involving the assembly and manufacture of lighters.

The presentation was followed by a detailed tour of the industrial plant. The student members and the faculties were guided by the heads of various departments in the industry. The members witnessed the various processes involved in the manufacturing of lighters and a doubt clearing session was arranged by the company after the tour. Refreshments were served after which the company staff thanked the members of the club. Overall, the program was an hour long. The student members went on to give feedback on the industrial visit and ended with a thanking note.

The industrial visit to Flamagas Pvt Ltd was a very enlightening and memorable exposure trip for the student members and faculty members alike. The trip gave insights on the inner dynamics of the management of an industry and ignited the inquisitive minds of the students.
