





- 5. To be give attention to students and have a good and positive connection with faculty so that they can have a good and friendly relationship with the students.



Department of Physics Action Taken Report


Following are the comments and suggestions by the faculty of the department of Physics after going through the parents' feedback:

The overall quality and usefulness of the undergraduate physics program is highly commendable by most of the parents. The core syllabi are framed by having UGC and TANCHE as benchmark and the courses are regularly updated in the Board of Studies.

In particular, the individual training given in physics lab sessions are highly appreciated. They also appreciated the variety of courses offered, and felt that it provides a broader scope for higher education. Some expressed interest in inclusion of practical everyday applications in core physics papers. It was discussed in the department that while most of the papers already have many applications interwoven, more current applications could be introduced in the next revision of syllabi. Few parents have requested to give class test for the portions everyday, so that the students will be forced to learn their lessons daily. The department offers remedial coaching for academically weak students on regular basis. Interested students may join these classes outside college hours and get trained if constant monitoring is needed.

Department of Plant Biology & Biotechnology Action Taken Report SUMMARY OF THE FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM BATCH OF 20201-2024

The parents of first year students from the department of Plant Biology and Plant Biotechnology were satisfied with the overall quality of the program, rating it at 77%. They were satisfied with the varied teaching methods employing activity based learning and practical experience gained by the student offered for each course. The teaching methodologies enhanced a deeper understanding of fundamental concepts and skill development. Suggestions for improvement are to offers career guidance programs, coaching for competitive exams, field trips.

SUMMARY OF THE FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM BATCH OF 2020-2023

Feedback response from the parents indicated on an average high satisfaction rate on different parameters. It was noticed that, majority of parents i.e., 73% of the parents have responded that, the overall quality of the program is good. It was found that, over 75% and 71% parents feel that, the usefulness of the program motivates their daughter for higher studies and placement. It was observed that 92% of parents were well satisfied with the availability of choices (electives) under choice-based credit system. It was found that, over 71% parents feel the program focuses on skill development. Majority of the parents were satisfied with the inclusion of current development in the curriculum.

Positive comments were received for adopting diverse Teaching methodologies adopted, strengthening theory through practical sessions, activities/programs that focus on skill development in students, including an internship component in the curriculum and teaching moral values to students in the class.

The least useful part of the curriculum reflected by the parents are Physical education class via online, notes not given to students and test based on only theory. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, the physical education class was changed to online platform and the notes were given to the students after teaching each topic. Apart from the tests, the students' learning was assessed with different measures such as seminar, quiz and assignments.

On analysing the feedback received by the parents, it is observed that parents are largely satisfied by the efforts made by the college.

SUMMARY OF THE FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM BATCH OF 2019-2022


The final year students from the Department of Plant Biology and Plant Biotechnology were thoroughly satisfied with the overall quality of the program and rated it as 86%. They cited that the most useful part of the Curriculum was learning practical techniques in all subjects. They emphasised that all subjects were useful and their practical skills were enhanced. The Seminars, Workshops, field trips helped them in supplementing additional knowledge for each course. The program was highly motivational and the students were able to easily relate their learnings in their day to day life. All the courses were highly relevant to the field of study with a score of 84%. The program helped them to think innovatively and motivated them to take up vocational courses which had bright future prospects and career placement. This aspect was scored as 81% and 78% respectively. The students suggested that the addition of more creative methods of learning, live demonstrations, Workshops and field trips to improve the Curriculum and to focus on skill development.

Action Taken:

The feedback received from the parents were discussed with the faculty who handled courses for the particular batch of students. The genuineness of the feedback was analysed and suggestions for improvement in teaching & curriculum if any were noted. Action plans were also discussed for improvement in these areas wherever necessary. From the forth coming academic year, the department has also decided to orient the first year students about the feedback questions provided as it was felt that irrelevant responses have been recorded by many parents as they were less aware of the existing curriculum.





 A Core Elective course in the semester VI on Wildlife Biology has been passed in the Board of Studies 2021-22, applicable from 2022 batch onwards.

 Practical course on Biology of Animals is offered in Semester I with sufficient activities and an experiment involving field study and a field trip to Shell Museum.

 Each semester has around 15 day order cycles. The course content for each practical course has been designed to complete the practical work, conduct two practical assessments and an ESE practical.
- More practical knowledge to be provided to improve their skill Skill development in terms of identification and classification of invertebrates, chordates, dichotomous taxonomic key, activities to identify the symmetry, types of scales in fish and types of feathers are developed during the Biology of Animals Practical. Staining techniques in Microbial Techniques Practical is usually conducted. However, due to the online mode of classes, this could not be done. Practicals such as water analysis, testing quality of milk samples and plotting bacterial growth curve were done in an offline mode.

Department of Home Science (UG) Action Taken Report

Nutrition Food Service Management and Dietetics (General Stream)

Based on suggestions and feedback from parents the following changes have been made:

- Internships have been made mandatory for students from the 2022 batch. Students will be sent on internships to hospitals, diet clinics, fitness centres, food processing units, hotels and the hospitality industry for minimum of 2 weeks to get an exposure to the industry. For other students who would still like to undergo an internship, a 2 week internship was arranged with one hospital and 2 Nutrition counselling centres and students underwent the internship for additional credits.
- Students are being taken on Field trips and industrial visits which are already part of the curriculum of many courses. It was not possible to take students on field trips earlier due to COVID 19 restrictions, but this is now being implemented.
- Seminars are a means of developing public speaking and presentation skills, this
 is also a means of developing teaching skills for future careers as suggested. We
 have seriously looked into the issue of seminars being a replacement for teacher
 teaching the course. It has been ensured that seminars if given to students will be
 on the application of a concept taught by the teacher or on a very simple topic
 already taught by the course teacher.
- Innovative teaching learning methodologies based on SCL (Student Centric Learning) and experiential learning is already practiced and is being reinforced.
- Parents want exposure to foreign Universities. Interested Students have attended orientation programs to study abroad programs at Liverpool Hope University, UK and Binary University, Malaysia. We have also organised talks by Faculty from Universities abroad.
- Webinars have been organised by the Department on Career opportunities in the Field of Dietetics and the hospitality sector as well as entrepreneurs

Department of Business Administration Action taken Report

The parents of the students of BBA were satisfied with the overall quality of the program, usefulness in preparing the students for higher studies and/or placements. The teachers have effective teaching mechanism and encourage students to participate in events consisting of co-curricular and extra-curricular events.


Some of the **least useful** part of the curriculum as per the parents were the learning of language papers, more practical mode could be included. owing to the pandemic, more practical approaches couldn't be implemented in online mode. With the shift from online back to offline, the curriculum and teaching has started to focus more on practical modes and more activity-based learning.

The parents also **recommended some suitable suggestions** to improve the syllabus like to include field and industrial visits (owing to the pandemic and online mode wasn't feasible in the previous year and will be incorporated in the coming years), to include more events and current skillsets in demand like website designing. Theory portions could be reduced with more emphasis on assignment and activity-based learning, adding more supportive courses and reducing or discarding topics that are redundant, repetitive or outdated (the department staff along with other academic experts scrutinize the syllabus at periodic intervals and eliminate redundancy and repetition with regard to the contents), to conduct more practical sessions, to have a regular meeting of the parents and teachers where the progress of the child can be tracked and suitable action taken appropriately. Students should be allowed to choose electives as per their interest and not restricted to the interest of the majority of students in the class. As per the criteria there should be a minimum number of takers for any elective course offered. If it is less than minimum requirement then the course cannot be offered by the department. So its restricted to offer as the reason stated above. Also they highlighted on conducting placement related training programs for final years.

The overall feedback has been quite positive and shortcomings if any were more owing to the pandemic which are looked into and are already being incorporated.

In a meeting, the Department comprehensively analyzed and discussed the data received regarding the feedback on curriculum from parents. The data was used to reflect on the various pedagogy of the Department and to take appropriate action in this regard.


The overall feedback on the curriculum was positive and a few parents mentioned the requirement of activity based teaching/ learning for students in classrooms. The Department deliberated on the same and the decision to include more pedagogical tools for experiential learning was taken. This will be incorporated by conducting hands on workshops, industrial visits, heritage walks, visits to libraries, participation in academic conferences and extra-curricular competitions outside of college, etc.

The concern about campus placements was mentioned and to address this, departmental level collaborations are underway with various institutions such as The Peninsula Foundation, National Institute of Advanced Studies and Centre for Chinese Studies for industry exposure. On the same lines, academic writing is encouraged and the II MA batch is presenting and publishing papers at a national conference this month.

The Department concluded that it is pertinent to identify the strengths of our students and encourage them with appropriate levels of challenges to tap their individual potential and expand the scope of the advisor-advisee system to include monitoring of their cognitive, social and emotional growth as well.

The faculty have been engaging in regular review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process to facilitate reflective practices in assignments and seminars. The students are expected to re-work on their assignments and seminars after the feedback from teachers. Student centric learning methods have been incorporated for better class participation and critical engagement.


