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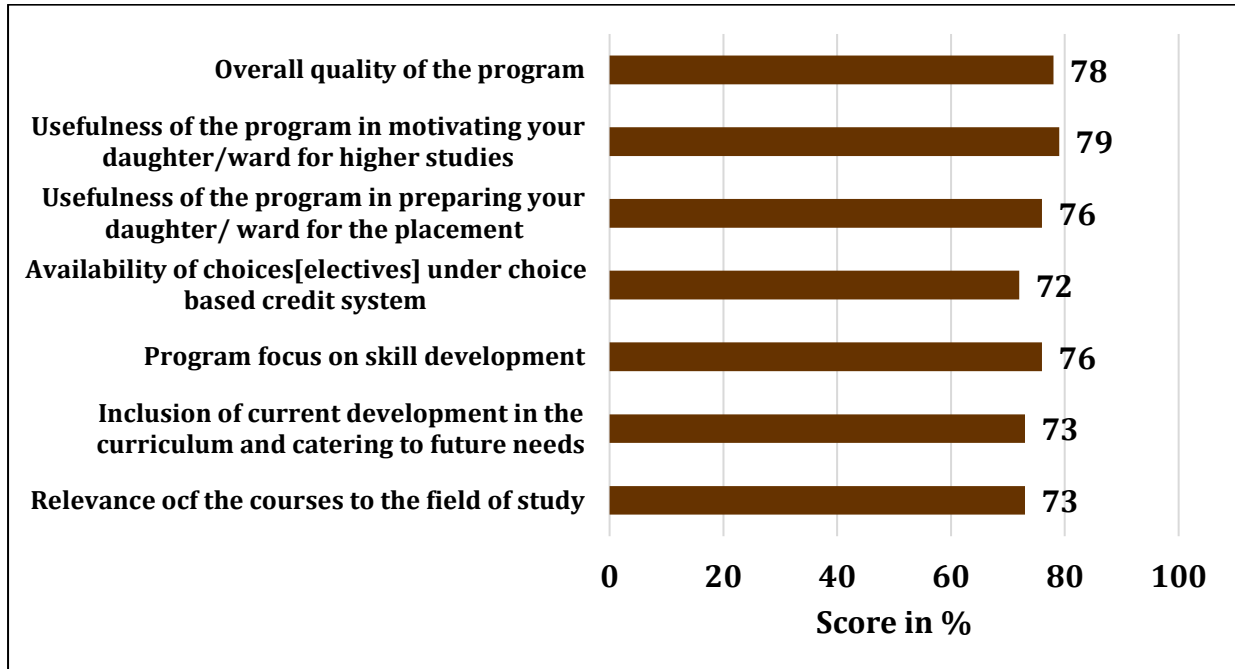
**Parents' Feedback Report: Department of History

1. I B.A. English

- a. UEN/SU/19 - Contemporary Tamil Literature in Translation will have the 3 hours End of Semester Examinations (ESE) from the batch of 2023 and will not include the practical component of Translation. It has been decided that Portfolio submission and evaluation will be applicable only for application-oriented courses and literature papers will have ESE.
- b. Course teachers have been instructed to explain every aspect of the Course Objectives and Learning Outcomes when they introduce the course and the syllabus at the beginning of the semester.
- c. Library hour is to be allotted by the course teacher if and when the need arises.
- d. Course teachers have been instructed to continue with the practice of combining group work & individual work for the process of learning and evaluation.

2. II B.A. English

- a. UEN/CO/49M - Life Narratives has only a couple of motivational speeches relevant to the trajectory and objectives of the course. The Department has decided to retain the syllabus for this course as it motivates and inspires students to reach greater heights.
- b. The Department justifies the need to retain the course, Readings in Literature in Semester III, as it pertains to wider temporal and spatial contexts of literatures written. Offering it in Semester 1 as suggested by some parents will be detrimental to the focus of such contexts.
- c. Most of the courses offered by the department are job-oriented courses and students have to do an internship at the end of Semester IV from the batch of 2021. The Department does not compel students to restricted choices of places of internship, and, insists on parental consent at the time of finalising an internship offer.
- d. The syllabi for English courses are updated regularly in the course of the Board of Studies held every academic year. For example, the Board of Studies held in early 2023, approved of the syllabi (i) Introduction to Travel Narratives (ii) Understanding Disability as being absolutely relevant and progressive, and, also of the inclusion of Annie Ernoux, the 2022 Nobel Laureate, in the course UEN/CO/49M - Life Narratives. The Board was again highly appreciative of the path-breaking syllabus of the supporting course UEN/SU/19 - Contemporary Tamil Literature in Translation, offered in Semester 1.
- e. Course teachers have been instructed to continue with the practice of combining group work & individual work for the process of learning and evaluation. They have also been instructed to explain every aspect of the

Course Objectives and Learning Outcomes when they introduce the course and the syllabus, at the beginning of the semester.

- f. Library hour will be allotted as per the discretion of the course teacher, to sustain referencing for research.

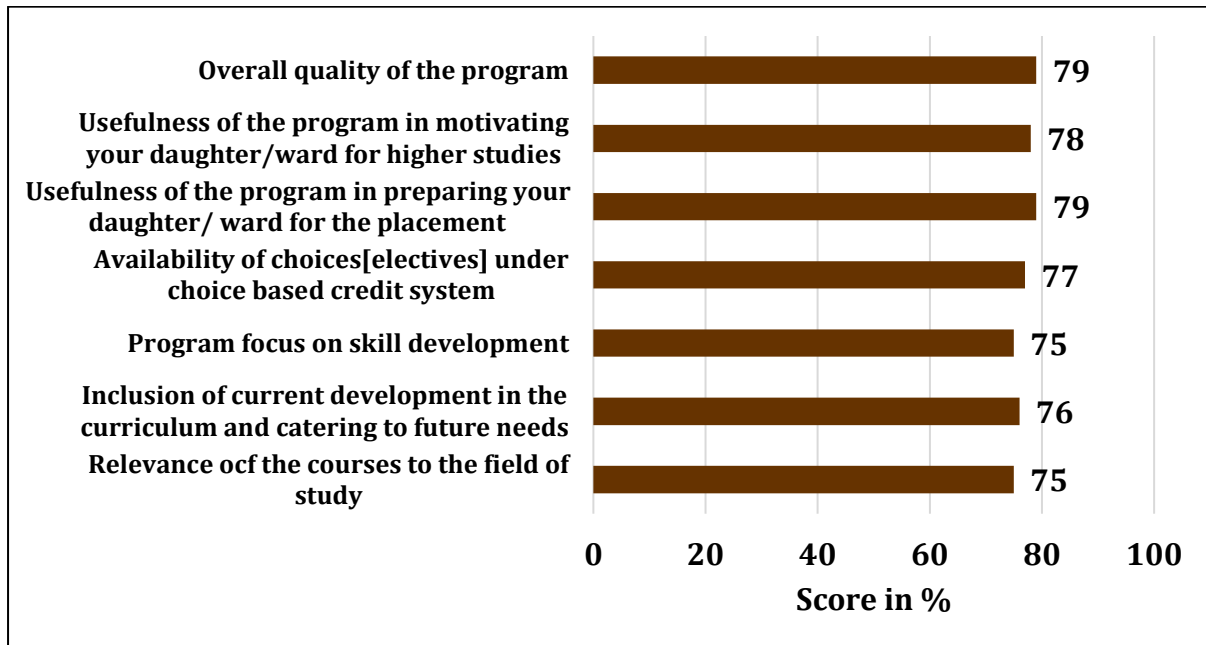
3. III B.A. English

- a. - d. Course teachers have been instructed to explain every aspect of the Course Objectives and Learning Outcomes when they introduce the course and the syllabus at the beginning of the semester.
- e. Course teachers have been instructed to continue with the practice of combining group work & individual work for the process of learning and evaluation.
- f. Library hour is to be decided upon by the course teachers, especially, to sustain the reading habit among students.

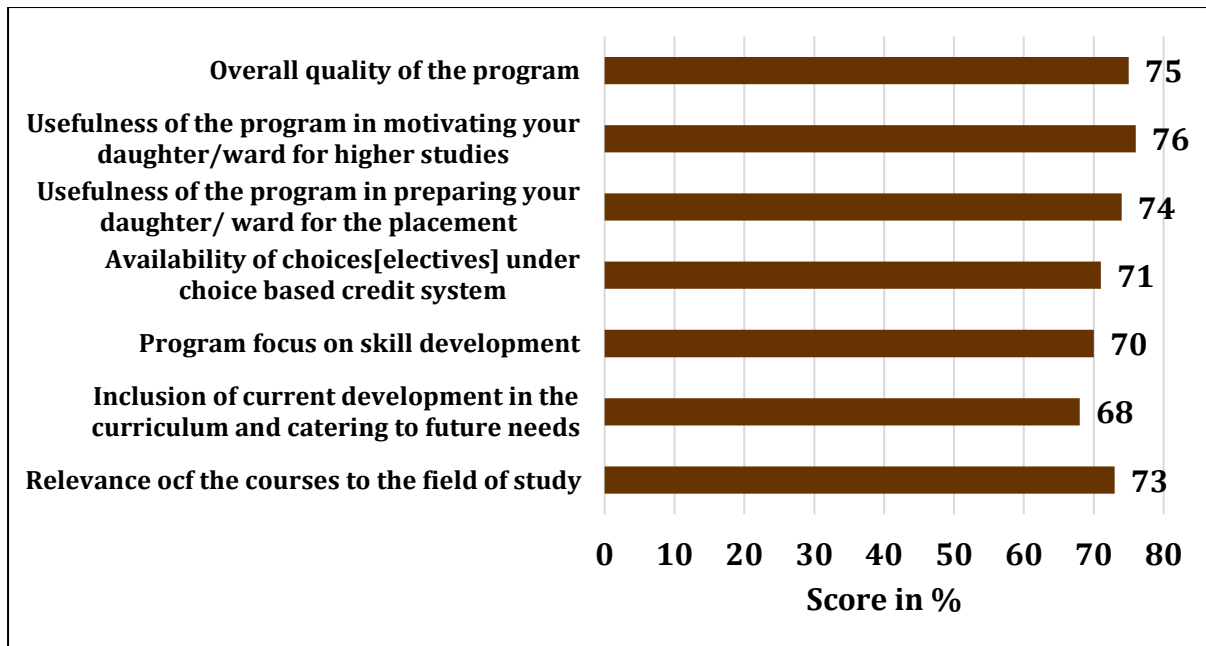

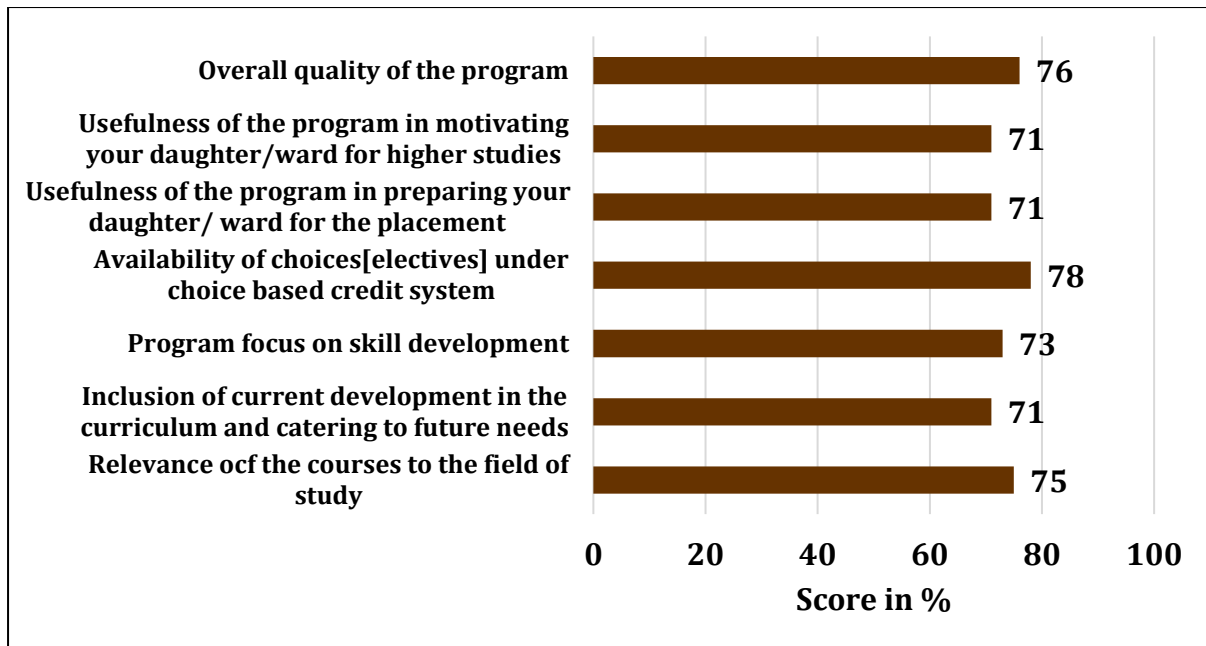

Assessment on the Curriculum for the course content and its relevance

The suggestions were consolidated and communicated to the members of the Boards of Studies and to all those who involve in the Syllabus Revision process including the University representative, the external members of the board, Industry Experts, Alumnae and the student representatives. The syllabus is restructured every year by considering the suggestions given and making appropriate changes in the syllabus to match the needs of the students and the industry.

Key Suggestions

Suggestion 1: Extra lab hours to be allocated for practical sessions.

The students were given the option of utilizing the lab during morning hours with prior permission.

Suggestion 2, 3 & 4:

- Certificate courses to be conducted on latest technologies
- Hands-on session workshop to work on current technology
- Seminar to be given by industrial resource person

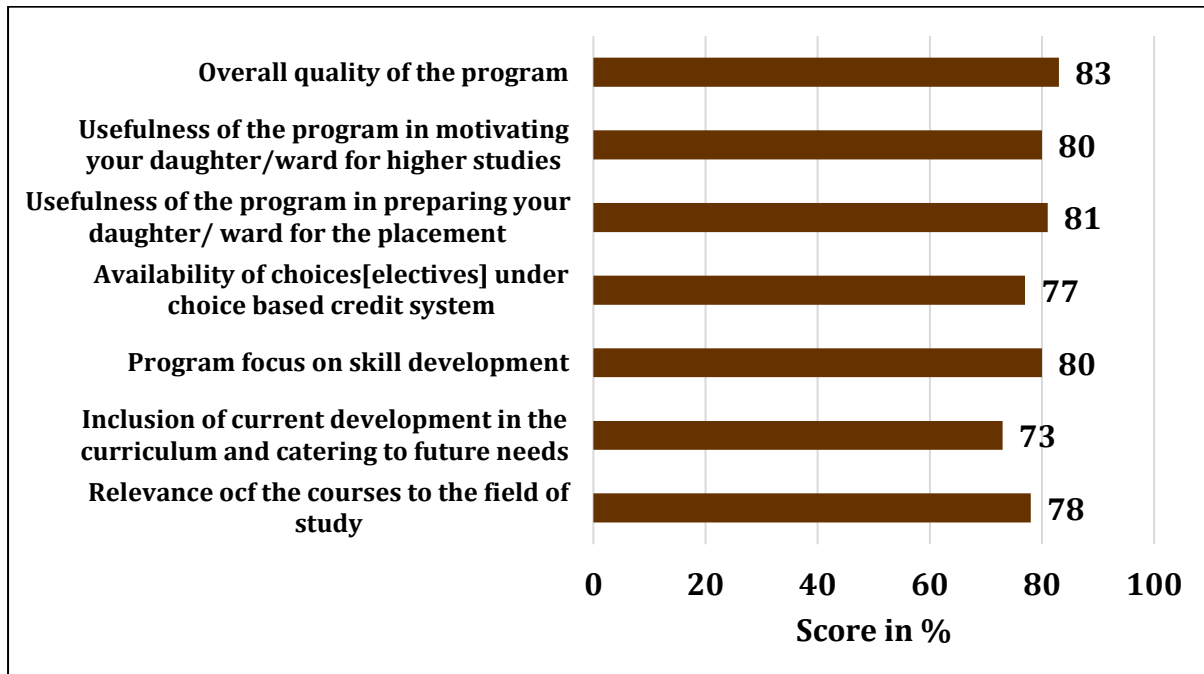
Conclusion

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Report of Actions Taken in Response to Parental Input on Curriculum

PG Department of English

The PG Department of English has received feedback from parents regarding various curriculum concerns. The department has taken appropriate action to resolve the concerns raised by this feedback. This report details the issues highlighted and the measures taken to resolve them.

Parents were concerned that the time allotted for completing assignments was insufficient. In response to this feedback, the following action has been taken by the department:

Teachers must incorporate assignments into their lesson plans and distribute schedules to students at the beginning of each semester.

This action will aid students in time management and prompt completion of assignments. By incorporating assignments into the lesson plan, instructors can ensure that students are aware of the semester's workload and due dates.

Parents were also expressed their dissatisfaction about the number of library hours allotted per semester. They felt that there were insufficient library hours for PG students. The department has evaluated the regulations of the University of Madras and determined that only one library hour can be allocated to postgraduate students. In order to facilitate this, the department has designed the course profile to allocate one hour per week in every semester.

Thirdly, parents were concerned about the breadth of the curriculum for British Literature: Twentieth Century and After. The department has assessed the course outline for British Literature: Twentieth Century and Beyond and taken measures to address the parents' concerns. By eliminating two poems and combining two courses, the revised curriculum will be more manageable for students and provide a superior educational experience. The new syllabus was passed in the Board of Studies meeting convened on 4th February 2023.

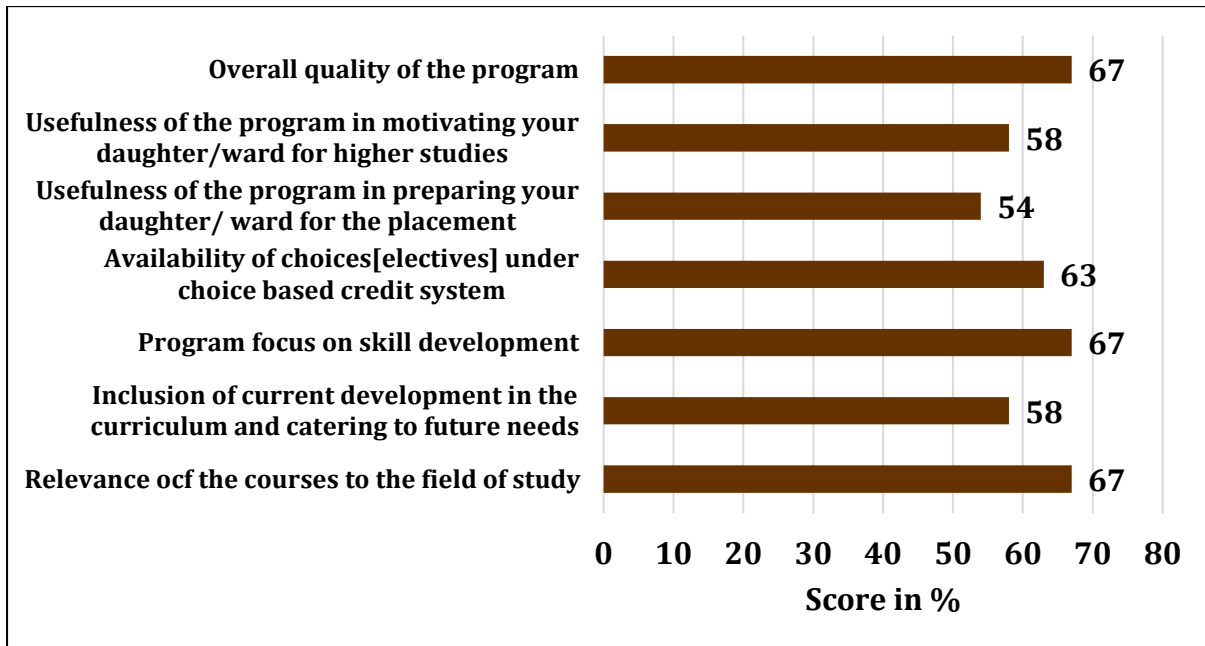
Conclusion:

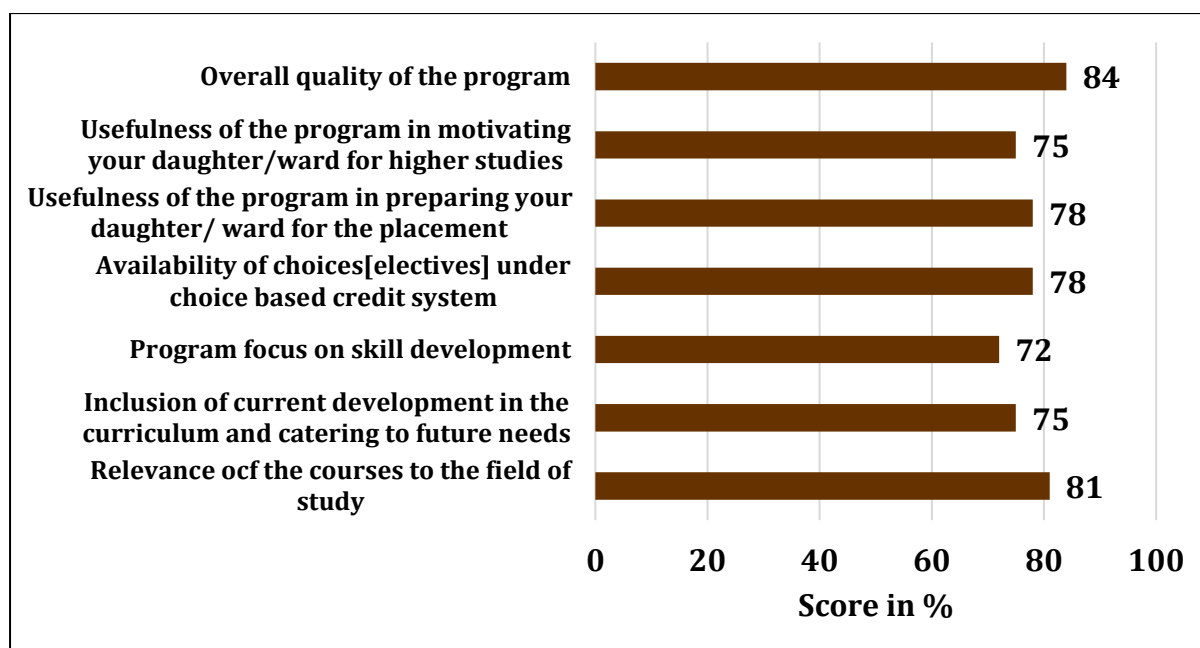

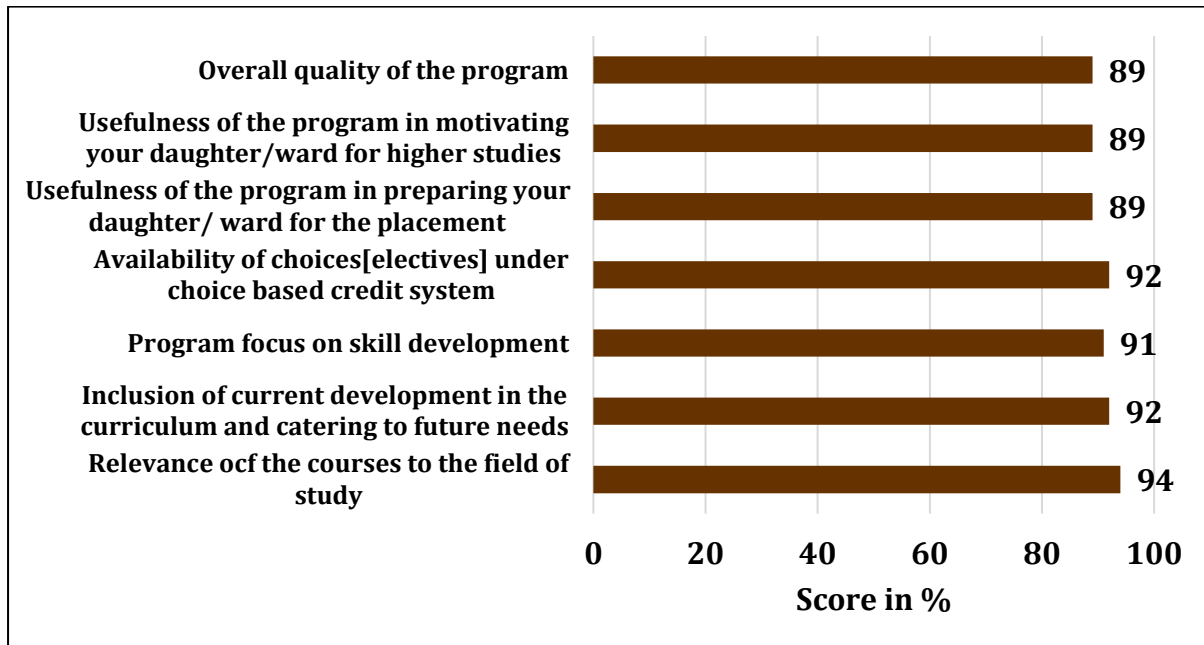
The concerns were the need for better studio facilities which is being addressed, as a high-end new studio is in the process of completion.

Following are the comments and suggestions by the faculty of the department of Physics after going through the parents' feedback:

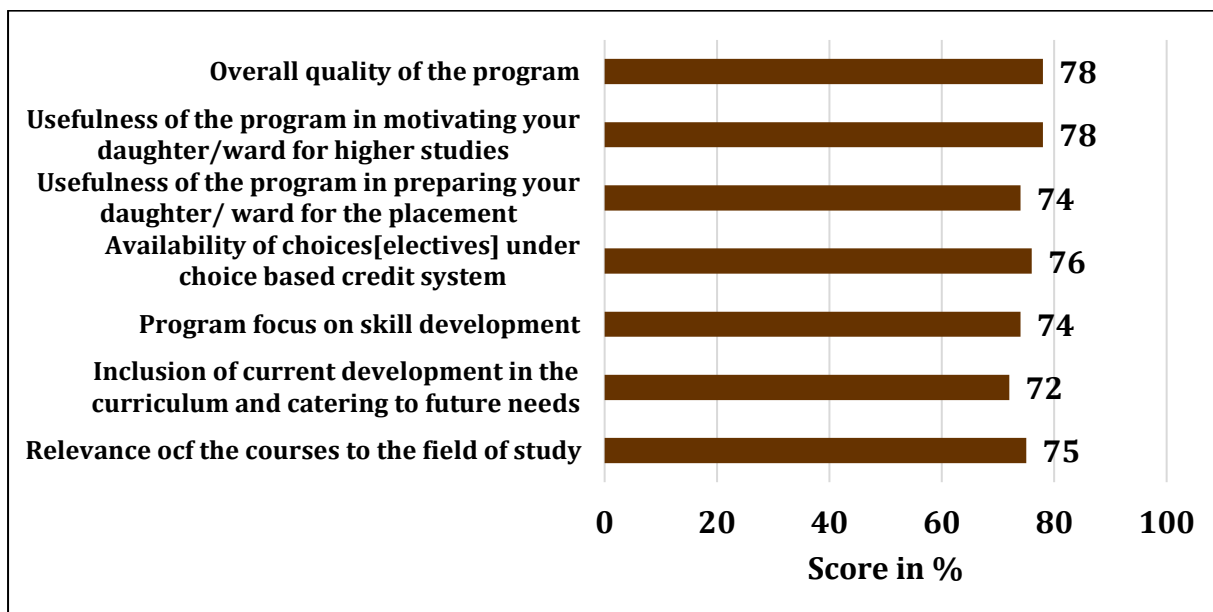
The overall quality and usefulness of the undergraduate physics program is highly commendable by most of the parents. The learner designed courses offered for the advanced learners are welcomed. The parents are satisfied and happy about the good teaching with remedial classes. In particular, the individual training given in physics lab sessions is highly appreciated. They also appreciate the variety of courses offered, and feel that it provides a broader scope for higher education. The participation of students in extracurricular activities are encouraged and more such opportunities are recommended.

Some expressed interest in inclusion of papers for skill enhancement. It was discussed in the department that already we are offering skilled-based papers such as Computing & entrepreneurial skills for physicists, Enhancing Personality, Practical Physics & Workshop practice and Numerical Physics. Few parents requested to conduct industrial visits for all the three year students. This academic year four industrial visits were arranged for the final year B. Sc. Physics students. The faculty of the department agreed that industrial visits could be arranged for all three years as requested from the next academic year. The concern of not learning the theory part of the practicals conducted in each semester was addressed to the students directly. The introduction of all the theory components or shuffling the experiments according to the theory is not practically feasible since each student is given individual apparatus for their labs and the sharing of equipment may not be advisable.

REPORT ON CURRICULUM FEEDBACK

BATCH 2022-2025

The parents of class I students of the Dept. of Plant Biology and Plant Biotechnology were satisfied with the overall quality of the program, rating it at 72%. The parents appreciated the program as the teachers were able to impart knowledge in the subject by updating according to the current developments, thereby encouraging students to pursue higher education. The curriculum is well planned in focussing on the fundamentals concepts of the course as well as catering to future needs. The lab sessions enabled the students to develop their practical skills. The theory and practical syllabi were correlating which gave the students an experience of balanced learning. Suggestions for improvement were to have activities conducted during the college hours. The parents commended that the overall syllabus of the degree program is useful. Parents have expressed their concern for not organising field trip during the academic year.

BATCH 2021-2024

The overall quality of Program has been marked to be very useful and motivating. Parents have reported that faculty catered to the future needs of the students by bringing out student talent and creativity. They nurtured students through the incorporation of current development into the curriculum. Parents appreciated teaching methodology, and the syllabi. The most useful parts of the curriculum are the practical sessions, educational trips and focus on skill development.

Parents are satisfied with everything, but need special consideration to relax strict attendance system, supplement sports coaching at college for interested candidates and need to include more elective based courses.

Parent's suggestion is also to improve the curriculum by including coaching systems for competitive examinations and improving /or including technology according to the course. More courses on biotechnology should be offered. Parents have also requested an increased practical classes and physical methods of learning.

BATCH 2021-2024

The parents were satisfied with the Curriculum and said that it was well designed. Based on the feedback given by the parents, it was observed that 74% said that there were choices available for Electives under Choice based Credit system. They cited that the most

useful part of the Curriculum was having a structured and interesting syllabi with practical, skill based courses, field trips, workshops and internships. They were appreciative of the Practical component as it developed their skill and also the seminars taken in class which improved their Presentation skills. The choices available for Elective courses were also considered as useful part of the Curriculum. 67% agreed that the program motivated their daughters for higher studies, focused on skill development and that the courses were relevant to their subject. 65% of the parents mentioned that the current development were included in the Curriculum which catered to the future needs of the students. 61% agreed that the program prepared their daughter for future placements.

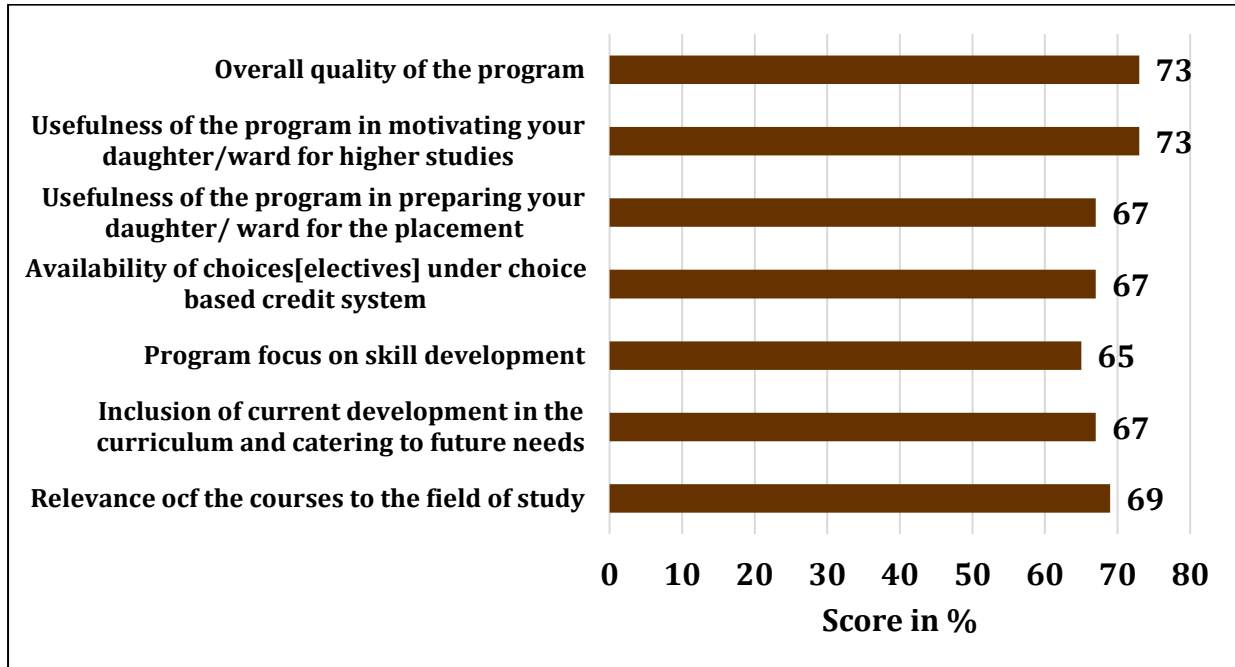
The majority believed that the Curriculum did not have any least useful part. However, it has been mentioned that taking average for Internal Assessment was not useful and relevant.
