### ACTIVITIES – 2019 – 2020

1. The department organized an Outreach Program on the topic **“Safe in the Cyber World”**. 12 students, accompanied by Ms. Mercy Evangeline, Assistant Professor of the department visited the Outreach Centre at Chennai on 28th and 30th August, 2019, to demonstrate how to effectively use online services. The students demonstrated the use of a few essential mobile apps necessary in day-to-day life and briefed them on the dos and don'ts of these Apps. The services provided encompass downloading and printing of online birth certificates/death certificates from the Chennai Corporation website (<http://www.chennaicorporation.gov.in>), obtaining a voter ID, registering for employment, enrolling for a PAN card and Aadhaar card, applying for TNPSC, and booking train and bus tickets online.



2. The final year B.Sc. Computer Science students were taken on an Industrial Visit to 'Sansbound - The Networking School', Kodambakkam, Chennai on 7th September, 2019. They attended a seminar on “Basics of Networking”, where they were briefed on the networking concepts with a practical viewpoint. They also visited the school's Lab facility and organised a demonstration on the working of network hardware. Dr. Shoba Leslie and Ms. L Jessilla Malarvizhi accompanied the students on this industrial visit. The students were able to identify the networking devices, assign IP addresses to machines, check the MAC address of their computer and resolve network issues.



3. The Annual Inter-Collegiate Tech meet “CompSync’ 20” was held on 21st February, 2020. The Tech meet was inaugurated by Ms. Krishna Jayanti, Team Lead, Verizon, an Alumna of the Department of BCA. Students from nine colleges participated in events like Tech Sync, Code-O-Fiesta, Brain Freeze, Tech Tunes, Face Tech, Snag and Trap, Brick Code and Werbung. These events provided them with a challenging platform to exhibit their technical knowledge and present their innovative ideas. **Stella Maris College, Chennai** won the coveted overall trophy.



4. The association of the Department of Computer Science – ‘Cyber Spark’ conducted “Spark Day”, an Intra-department technical event, on 18th December, 2019. Students from all three years within the department took part in a range of events, including Connections, Quiz, and Debugging, which helped them develop their technical skills. The event helped many students exhibit their leadership skills as well as cultivate a sense of teamwork.
