1. III B.A. English students (64 students) went on a field trip to Pallikaranai Marshland and Crocodile Bank, Chennai as part of their coursework for Ecoliterature (UEN/CO/41M). They were escorted by their 2 course teachers, Dr. Lilian I Jasper and Dr. C. Anupama. Students observed the degradation of the ecozone, including the indiscriminate dumping of toxic solid waste along the road, sewage discharge, and the construction of buildings, railway stations, and a new road connecting Old Mahabhalipuram Road and Pallavaram, which has significantly reduced the size of the Pallikaranai wetland.

The Crocodile Bank is home to 17 species of crocodilians, and a field based conservation outfit, as it has a collection of captive animals for safekeeping. The captive breeding of endangered species lies at the heart of the learning process through this field trip.
