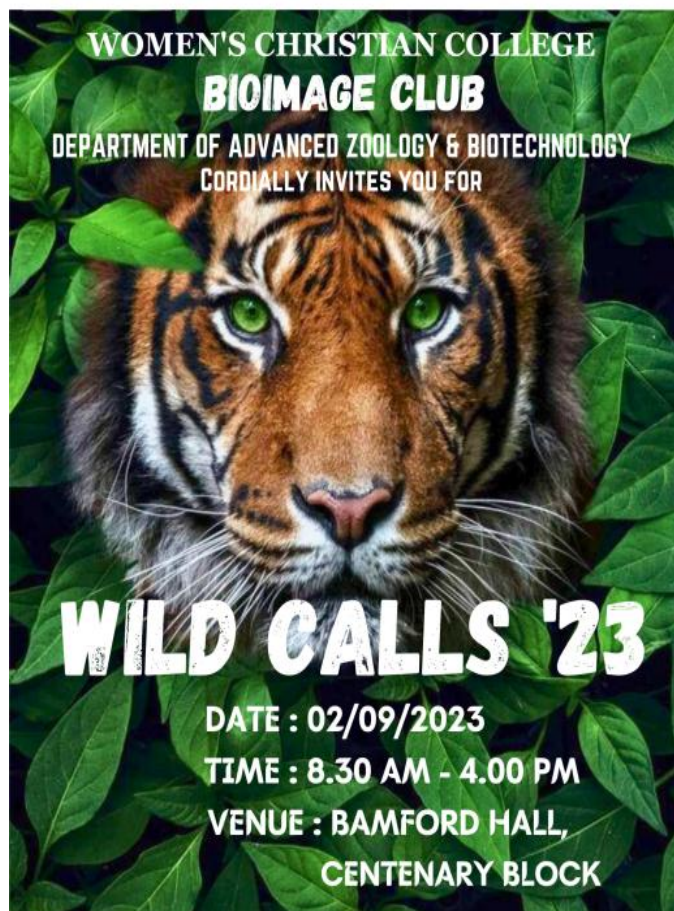

INAUGURATION:

The Inauguration of WILD CALLS '23 began at 09:00 am in the Bamford Hall, Centenary Block. 3. DOODLEPEDIA [DOODLING]

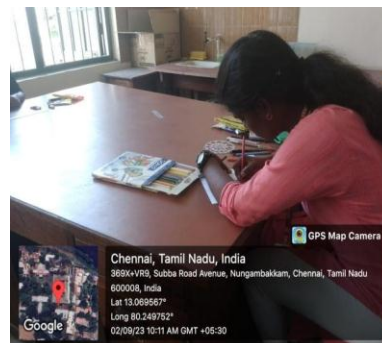

4. ZOOLOGICAL BLEND [POTPOURRI]

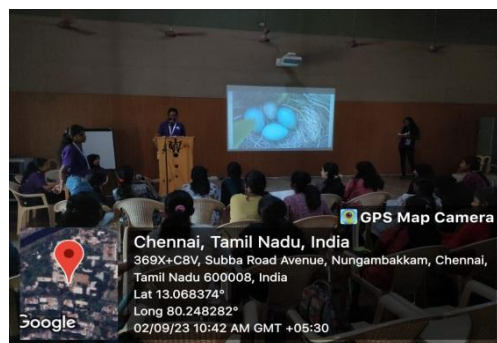

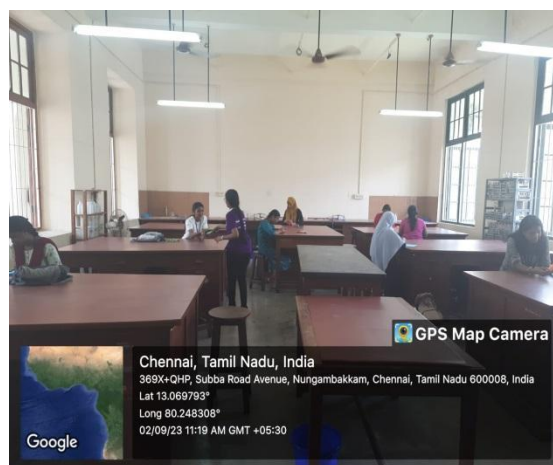
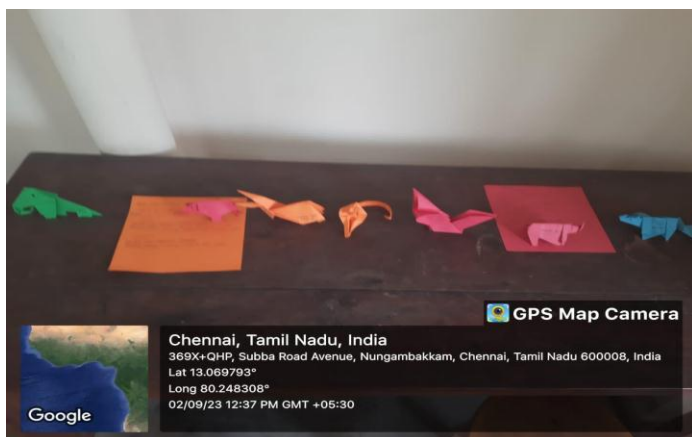

6. PHOTOTASTIC [PHOTOGRAPHY]

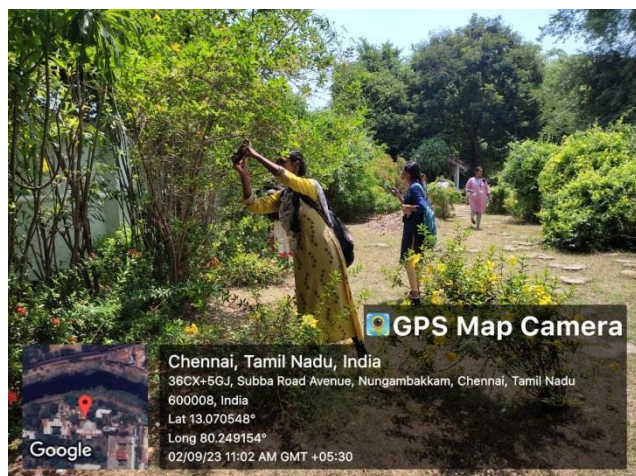

7. WIZQUIZ [QUIZ]

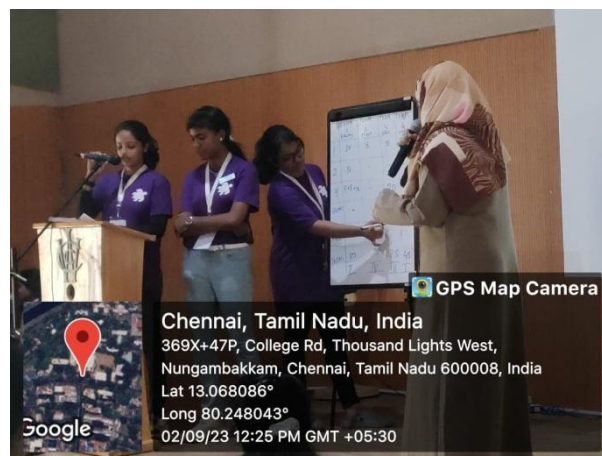
Timing: 11:30 am – 12:30 pm

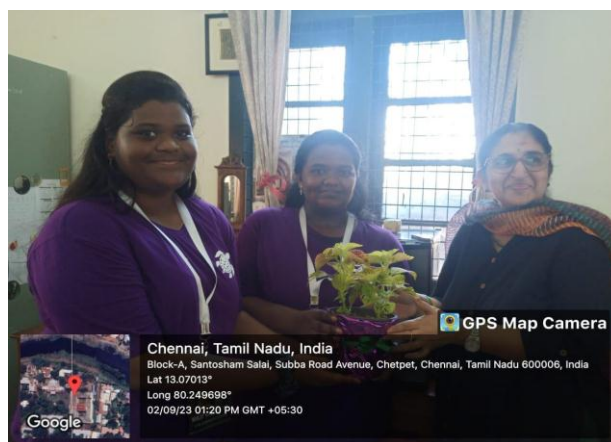

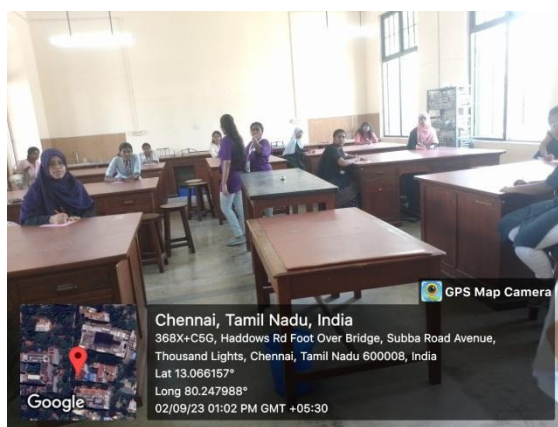


11. WORD WIZARDRY [SPELL BEE]

12. EMOTION IN MOTION [MIME]

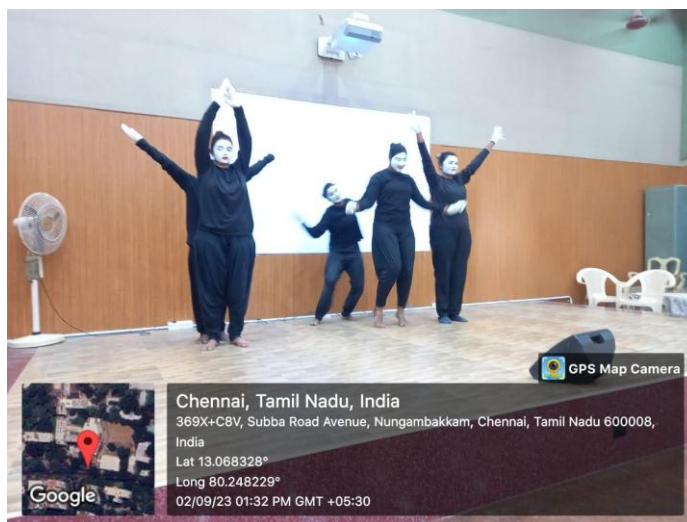
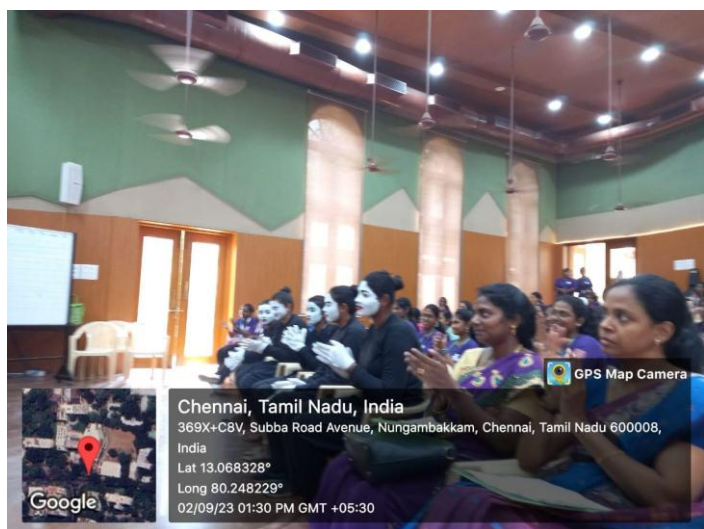
