II BCA students created a model which explains automatic switching off and on of the street light in the public street. The model is designed with LED lights which represents as street lights. LDR (Light Dependent Resistor) sensor is used to senses the darkness of the light. The sensed data is transmitted to LED lights through positive and negatively connected wires. Based on the darkness of the light which was sensed by the LDR sensor, the light gets automatically blowing. When the light is sensed by the sensor, the LED lights will be switched off automatically. The project was viewed by people of all age categories. School students also showed their interest on the model they were able to understand the working model of automatic off and on of the street light which was explained by our students.
