### 1. Exhibition- Household Waste Management

The Department of Corporate Economics, Women's Christian College organized an exhibition on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022, in the centenary building lobby on the topic- **HOUSEHOLD WASTE MANAGEMENT**.

As part of their EVS curriculum, the students of **I B. A Corporate Economics** presented various models and ideas on how to manage waste at the grassroot level and showcased various processes, remedies and suggestions on waste management. The exhibition was organized to create awareness among students on how they need to address the issues regarding waste management which is one of the current problems facing the country. The exhibition was held from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 pm in the CB lobby and was open to all the students.

As the exhibition started, students presented their projects on different segregation of waste management, Kitchen garden, Terrace Garden, House hold waste management, how to manage E- Waste,, waste management in Chennai, methods of waste -Reduction, Reuse, Recycle, Role of conservancy workers- where they had taken interviews and expressed problems relating to people working in this area, students also compared the waste management techniques used in other countries and the possibilities of being more efficient in terms of managing waste, they also addressed health impacts of waste management and environmental damages due to waste, and companies involved in waste management. the students also organised visual presentations to help everyone understand the concepts of their working models. With all these models they were successfully able to showcase and create awareness among students on the importance of Household Waste Management.
