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### ONLINE\_WORKSHOP ON APTITUDE TRAINING



### WEBINAR ON THE TOPIC "DISSEMINATING MEASI PRIME PEDAGOGY"



#### SPSS WORKSHOP

The resource person was Dr. A. K Subramani, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Management Studies, St. Peter's College of Engineering. The highlights were how to frame the structured questionnaire, how to fix scale on each question, how to import questionnaire from Excel to SPSS, various analysis like parametric and non-parametric tools and how to interpret the results.
