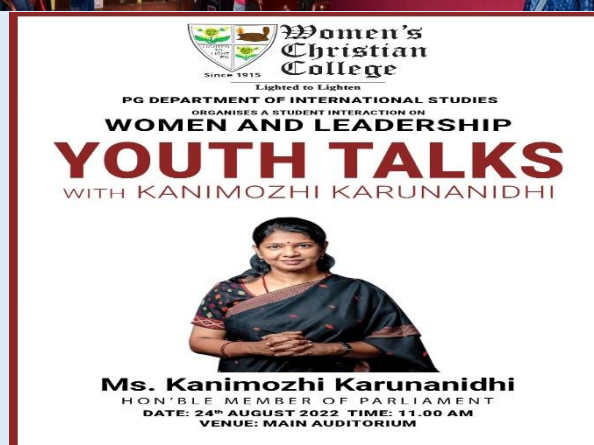
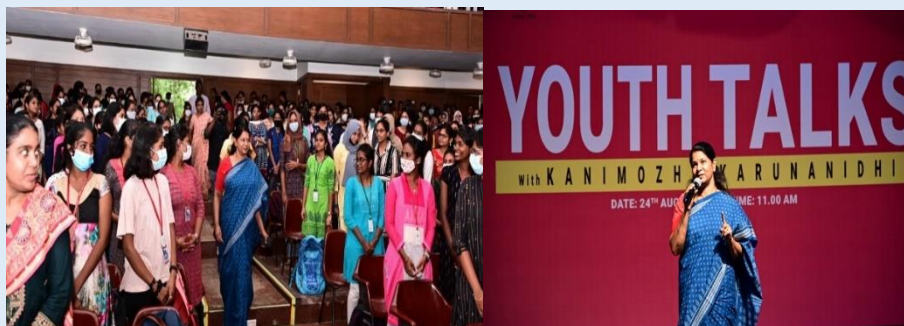


## PG DEPARTMENT OF INTERNATIONAL STUDIES

#### Guest Lectures, Seminars and Workshops
