The Academic Audit members had scored each parameter on a 10-point scale and the overall Observations of the Committee based on the inputs received from the departments are:

Strengths:

- Enormous number of webinars/workshops on a variety of topics participated by the faculty reflect their interest in enriching their knowledge
- Notable faculty activities and teaching methodologies adopted by almost all the departments.
- Number of patents awarded to faculty has increased to four.
- Development of E-Content modules/Videos has been undertaken by most of the faculty.
