





Report for Parents' Feedback

The Department of History met on 19/03/2024 to discuss the Parents Feedback for the year 2023-2024.

It was observed that the majority of the answers were not clear or random and so it was evident that they did not fully understand the questions. There were a number of contradictory responses - for example: I year parents have stated that the portions are too vast and also to include more dynasties. Similarly some of the parents have stated that skill development is lacking while some have appreciated skill development. I Year parents have requested for an International Relations paper, but it is already offered in the VI semester.

Majority of the parents are not very educated so they are not able to understand and comprehend the questions in English. hence the Department once again suggests for the questionnaire to be given in English and Tamil..

They have asked for geographical history, but it is also covered in all history papers within the subtopics.

It was noticed that no concrete suggestions were given by the parents







Action Taken Report- Subsequent to Parents' Feedback on Open Day- 3.2.2023

1. I B. A. English

- a. In the context of introducing evolving paradigms of thought in literature, and enabling students to think on their own, guides may not be available in the market. Primary sources are made available by the course teachers. Secondary sources are available in the library and on internet. Library hour is to be allotted by the course teacher, if and when the need arises.
- b. Syllabi with Reading Lists have been shared with students to enable parents' perusal of the same every year.
- c. Two courses on Indian Literatures are offered in semesters 5 and 6. There is even a course Contemporary Tamil Literature in Translation enabling exploring culture in region specific contexts. Besides, there is a fair distribution of texts written by Indian writers in other courses as well.
- d. Compulsory Physical Education cannot be done away with, as it adheres to the norms laid down by the University of Madras.
- e. A majority of student assignments are geared towards training students in oral presentations in most courses.
- f. There is an array of courses that promote reading, writing and speaking skills. In fact, the syllabi for English for Communication Skills courses offered in four semesters to all students are framed to cater to the aforementioned skills.

Action taken on Parents' Feedback

Following are the comments and suggestions by the faculty of the department of Physics after going through the parents' feedback:

The overall quality and usefulness of the undergraduate physics program is highly commendable by most of the parents. The parents are satisfied with the choices available for the core elective papers and feel that it provides a broader scope for higher education. The individual training given in physics lab sessions, projects, continuous tests, problem-solving and skill development programs are highly appreciated. They also appreciate the newly introduced service-learning course and the importance given for the extension activities and extracurricular activities. The inclusion of current developments in the curriculum and the relevance of the course are recognized by the parents.


Some expressed interest in arranging programs to motivate students towards higher education. It was discussed in the department that already we are conducting enough number of curricular activities and more recently have organized a career awareness program with 10 resource speakers from various job profiles. The concern of not learning the theory part of the practicals conducted in each semester was addressed to the students directly along with the fact that core physics papers would have more of theory rather than applications. Enough applications are already incorporated in the curriculum wherever needed. Also, they were reminded of the fact that problem-solving has been integrated into the curriculum by making the assignment component of the continuous assessment a problem test to make sure that every student is forced to do numerical problems related to the subjects taught. This also prepares the students for the entrance exams for their higher studies. It was surprising to observe that the parents were concerned about their wards being prepared for placement. This year out of the 40 final year students, only 3 students have opted for campus placement. All the others are interested in higher studies.

Feedback analysis report 2023-2026

The parents of first year students from the department of Plant Biology and Plant Biotechnology were pleased with the overall quality of the program. It was rated at 78%. Their views on usefulness of the Program's scope for higher studies was rated at 75%, while that for placements was rated to be 74%. The program focusing on skill development was graded at 70% while the relevance of the course at 71%. The relevance of the course of study and availability of electives for CBCS were rated at 67%. The parents were contented with the varied teaching methods which incorporated activity based learning. The practical skills owned by the student during the practical class was appreciated as one the useful part of the curriculum. The teaching methodologies enhanced a deeper understanding of fundamental concepts and skill development. Suggestions for improvement were to offer more career guidance programs, increased activity based learning, daily/weekly tests to be conducted so that there would be more individual focus on students.

Feedback analysis report 2022-2025

Feedback response from the parents indicated on an average high satisfaction rate on different parameters. It was noticed that, majority of parents i.e. 81% of the parents have responded that, the overall quality of the program is good. It was found that, 81% parents feel that, the usefulness of the program motivates their daughter for higher studies and placement. It was observed that, around 75% parents have said that, the availability of choices (electives) under choice-based credit system. It was found that, over 75% parents feel the program focus on skill development. Majority of the parents were satisfied with the inclusion of current development in the curriculum.

Special comment was given on the useful part of the curriculum are way of teaching and program focus on skill development. The least useful part of the curriculum reflected by the parents are inclusion of extracurricular activities to students.

On analysing the feedback received by the parents, it is observed that parents are largely satisfied by the efforts made by the college.

Recommendation and Suggestions:

- **1.** Extracurricular activities to be included in various courses.
- **2.** Explanation has to be given in both languages (English and Tamil).





Feedback analysis report 2022-2025

The parents were satisfied with the Curriculum and said that it was well designed. Based on the feedback given by the parents, it was observed that 74% said that the program was useful in motivating their daughters/wards for higher studies. 72% believed that the program was useful in preparing their daughters/wards for placement. 73% believed that the choices available for Elective courses were also considered as useful part of the Curriculum sand that the program focused on skill development. They were appreciative of the assignments and practicals given to the students and felt that these helped the students to explore the subjects in depth. The parents believed that the teaching by the staff helped the students to understand the concept.

The majority believed that the Curriculum did not have any least useful part. However, it has been mentioned that latest topics should be added to the courses and that placement opportunities pertaining to this field was limited.

The parents had suggested that more companies who are related to this subject should be called in for campus placement. Parents also suggested that students to be given the chance to learn other languages as a NME course for one semester.







I YEARS

1. Programs on skill development

Skill development courses are offered by the English department in semester 1 and 2.

2. Sports

40 hours of sports (Physical Education) is compulsory as per the Madras University Guidelines

3. Need more practical knowledge

In semester these students have 4 hours of Core Practical (Biology of Animals Practical) and 2 hours of Supporting Practical (Microbial Techniques). Core practical includes dichotomous key, activities such as collection and identification of scales of fishes and feathers in birds and identification, classification and unique features of organisms from Protozoa to Mammalia. Field visit to Vedanthangal was organized on 20th February 2024 to observe and identify the avian fauna. In Microbial Techniques the students carry out the different staining techniques of bacteria, analysis of water and milk samples and related instrumentation.

4. Need more tests

Every semester two CIA's are given and they are assessed for two assignments. Eligible students who were absent for the CIA are given Compensatory Tests. Periodically, during class hours, specific topics are given by the course teachers for the students to study and a short test is conducted.

II YEARS

The Skill Based course on IT Tools for Biologists & Bioinformatics is designed to enable the student to gain competence in the use of all MS Office applications and trains them to Bioinformatics tools. The labs are conducted at the IT Lab at the CB and each student is provided with a desktop to work at her own pace and gets a hands-on learning experience. Two teachers are there for this course to demonstrate all components of the syllabus and students are encouraged to practice the same at home and submit as assignment in the Google Classroom.

2. Studying the internal system of organisms

This comment as the least useful part of the curriculum is irrelevant because they do not study the internal system of organisms in the courses offered in the second year (Cell Biology, Biochemistry and Classical & Molecular Genetics). Study of the internal system is part of their Core courses in first and second year and is a vital part of their curriculum without which they cannot understand the functioning of the various organs.

3. Students should be encouraged to become more aware of the wilderness on campus and provided with ample opportunities to document the local biodiversity thereby contributing towards Citizen Science.

Study of campus Biodiversity in the form of Biodiversity Assessment is an essential part of Biology of Animals Practical where they document insects on campus. Observing and recording the campus Biodiversity is an integral part of courses like Environmental Biology and Field Zoology which is offered in semester six. Five students of the second year are doing an internship on Urban Wilderness Walk organized by the Madras Naturalist Society, which was open to all. If genuinely interested, they could have enrolled for the program.

4. Extension of classes after regular time. Boarding the van becomes problem.

In the practical course on Cytogenetics and Biochemistry some of the experiments are time consuming and requires precise handling to get the required results. The experiment schedule





will be reworked to address the concern of the students but the desired output solely rests in the efficiency of the student in following the instructions.

5. Taking students for industrial visits

A visit to the department of Human Genetics and the department of Clinical Research, Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research was organized on the 8th of March as part of their practical course Cytogenetics and Biochemistry.

During summer vacation compulsory internship is offered from the present II year batch, which will provide an opportunity for them to have hands-on training at eminent labs, research institutions and hospitals.

6. Field work can be incorporated

Service Learning component at TREE Foundation is offered for extra credits. This is open to all. However only ten students opted for this program.
